**23rd October, 1863**

The peace of Christ, which passes all our understanding, as a greeting to you and your whole household.

Dear Father,

As I have the chance to send along a short note, I would like to greet you and yours most sincerely. We are all well, thank God, and hope the same of you. Dear Father, if Georg Kleinich, to whom I have written, should come to us, then Anna would like to have 4 woollen skirts with white stripes as petticoats, and 40 ells of check linen for weekday skirts sent along. She requests that you purchase these for her and send them with G. Kleinich, hoping that he can advance the money for us. The woollen skirts also need not be made up, but only the material be sent. Dear Father, today I have neither the time nor the space to write more. I commend you to the grace of God, and please greet Mother and all the children from me. Greet also my mother and brothers and sisters and all who love Jesus.

I have now been in Ebenezer amongst our Wendish people for more than 6 months. We have a happy marriage in the fear of the Lord, and we also recognize that it is nothing but grace and fatherly guidance that has so wonderfully led us together, and we are sincerely grateful for it. Our dear children are also obedient and well behaved, and devoted and attached to us. Thank the Lord for all he has done for us. His name be praised for ever. Amen. Now, my dearly beloved parents and brother and sisters, I remain your loving sister.
