There is a larger kind of double daisy. I ordered one last week from Clare.

How is your Mariechen? Is she in the Kapunda Hospital or was she operated on at home? Herbert was also to be operated on; he has a rupture. I do not know when this is to take place He is now going to school and likes it. His teacher says he is doing very well.

Heinrich has started putting in the crop now but it is still very dry.

We now have a well in our yard; it is 27 feet deep. The Stork is expected to rattle on the roof at Richard's middle of next month, [Frieda – R. Z.], but I heard this only indirectly.

The daisy has still not arrived, but may do so next week.

I shall close with many greetings from us to you all.
